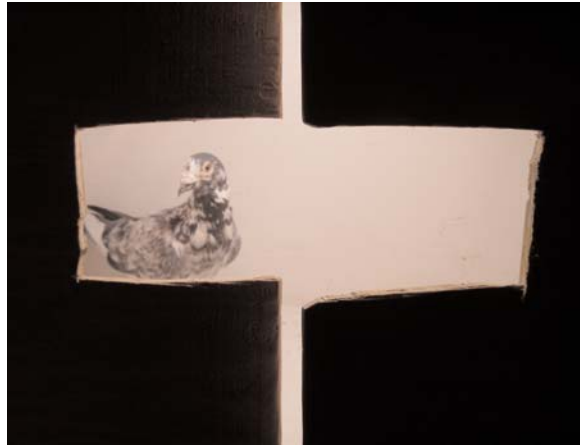

Pictures from Lookout Mountain

Tulsa, OK. Jeremy Lambertson's *Pictures from Lookout Mountain*, a multi-media exhibit, featuring "pigeon portraiture" and other photos can be viewed in the PAC's Gallery from Dec. 5-25.

Lamberton was born and raised in Tulsa. After earning degrees in filmmaking and photography from Webster University in St. Louis, he moved back to Tulsa to live on Lookout Mountain Ranch, which has been in his family for four generations.



Lamberton is interested in breaking from photographic tradition, experimenting with new technologies and, in this exhibition, "expanding upon the work of the Dutch masters of pigeon portraiture."

He is the co-founder and director of the Tulsa Overground Film Festival, which celebrated its tenth anniversary in December 2007. Currently, he is directing and editing a feature-length documentary, which is scheduled to premiere in early 2009.

The PAC Gallery is free and open to the public. Gallery hours are Monday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and during Chapman Music Hall Events. Access to the Gallery is from the PAC's lobby on Third Street and from the parking garage's south elevators.
